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syringe. Multiple carton variations were needed to accommodate single, double and triple packs of the devices. While the product had received regulatory approval, and a launch date was set, the specialized packaging machinery required for high-speed carton forming and product insertion was still months away from installation. This presented a significant time-to-market challenge. Traditional methods of flat-shipping cartons for automated assembly at the customer's facility were not feasible within the required timeframe.

Recognizing the urgency, besides developing six unique carton and partition designs in close collaboration with the customer, we deployed our unique Hand Assembly and bindery service. A dedicated team of over 100 skilled individuals meticulously hand-assembled the cartons and partitions using custom-designed jigs, replicating the precision of automated machinery. Over a period exceeding a year, while the customer's packaging equipment was being built and installed, our Hand Bindery team assembled over 3 million cartons, ensuring an uninterrupted supply of the life-changing treatment.

By using our Hand Assembly and bindery service, we enabled our customer to launch their product on schedule, providing patients with timely access to this treatment. The precise hand assembly ensured a seamless transition to automated packaging once the customer's equipment was installed.
